1. When you think about someone in your life who has been really faithful, who comes to mind? What did they do that impacted you?

2. Read Ruth 4:1-4. Do you think that Boaz wanted this other family member to marry Ruth instead of him? How does Boaz demonstrate here that he is a man of integrity? Do you feel like it is hard to have integrity in this current culture? Why or why not?

3. Read Ruth 4:5-12. How did the people of the town respond to seeing the integrity and faithfulness of Boaz? How do you think seeing the story of Ruth & Boaz affected their faith?

4. Read Ruth 4:13-18. How did God end up blessing the faithfulness of Ruth & Boaz? Have you experienced God's blessings in your life when you have been faithful? What did you do and what did God do as a result?

5. Next Steps: In verse 17, we see the son of Ruth & Boaz becomes the grandfather to King David, an ancestor to Jesus himself! If God can do this out of Ruth's circumstances, what could he do in yours? Are you facing difficult circumstances right now? This week pray each day, 'Lord, I trust you for...' Watch for what He does in your life.
